- Eliminate data terrorism
- Implement data quality strategy and framework
- Establish and promote proactive strategies to prevent data quality issues from arising
- Build and maintain strong relationships with process owners and subject matter experts to secure lasting resolutions to data quality issues
- Work with various teams within the Bank to establish and maintain standards for managing data quality issues throughout the delivery lifecycle and in production
- Assist and assess the suitability of data in the design phase of new products and projects.
