- Collaborate with colleagues to ensure a common, high quality approach to software testing across Oxbury.

- Preparing results documentation and presenting the outcome of testing activities.
- Experience with best practices in UX and a willingness to help improve the user experience.
- Distributed source control (we use Git).
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Self-starter.
